City of Columbus, University District Street Parking Information 2022

Most streets around the University District require a permit to park during specific hours on those streets. The city sells permits to residents who have valid lease agreements on the streets which require them. You can learn more about the requirements and visit an eligibility map here:

The City has noted that issuing a pass can take up to 10 business days if an individual applies via the online portal, and you may need to go to their office in person with your required documentation if a pass is needed sooner. The physical address and availability are as follows:

- Open M F, 10 AM to 5 PM

If your address shows as eligible on the eligibility map, but the city's online service will not let you purchase a permit online, you may also need to go in person.
