SETTING UP YOUR UTILITIES: A QUICK GUIDE

Utilities should be set up in your name about 10 days before the lease starts so you do not experience a disruption of service. Sometimes, it's easier to call each provider to set up service instead of doing it online, as the online setups can be finicky with recognizing addresses. Once you're set up, these providers will issue you a monthly bill either by mail or email. Generally, roommates each pick a utility to set up and use Venmo to bill & pay each other for the service.

Setting up Gas and Electric service is mandatory (unless otherwise noted below) while Internet and/or Cable are not. Water is included at all Inn Town Homes properties.
