Most streets* around the University District require a permit to park during specific hours on those streets. The streets are marked with signage indicating the parking permit requirements. The city sells permits to residents who have valid lease agreements on the streets which require them. You can learn more about the requirements and visit an eligibility map here:

IMPORTANT: You will need to bring/provide your government issued photo ID, license plate #, and a fully signed copy of your lease agreement as proof of residency. You can access your signed and countersigned lease agreement by going to your portal home page, scrolling down to "Current Lease" and hitting "Download PDF."

The City has noted that issuing a pass can take up to 10 business days if an individual applies via the online portal, so you may need to go to their office in person with your required documentation if a pass is needed sooner. Likewise, if your address shows as eligible on the eligibility map, but the city's online service will not let you purchase a permit online, you may need to go in person to purchase a pass.
